

# Table Topper Class

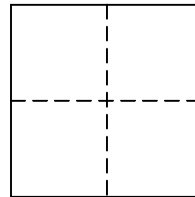
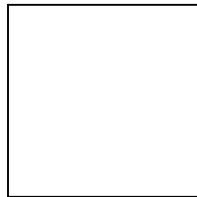
Let's talk about some classes I've been doing. I wanted to kick the 52"x52" Table Toppers off to a good start. I booked all my classes in November and December as "Table Topper Classes". I charge \$25.00 per person and that includes the 'table topper', the transfer and the use of my paints (if they don't have their own). These went over so well that some of them from November booked another one in December. They make nice gifts and painting on the perma press is a dream.

I taught them how to place transfers on tablecloths – no matter what size or shape that they are. It's really easy. Take your tablecloth and fold it in half. Now take that and fold it in half again. Now your tablecloth is folded in quarters. Take it over to your iron and iron in the folds that you just made.

If you want a design just on the corners – center your transfer in the center of the quarter fold – with the paper edges touching the edges of the material.

If you want the designs on the sides and ends – center you transfer on the lines that you just ironed in – with the edge of the transfer the same distance from the edge each time.

If you want the design only in the center of the tablecloth – center the transfer over the ironed lines that are all the lines coming together in the middle of the tablecloth.



Under the tablecloths we used the blotter pads. The material is so good that is all you need.

You can use the table toppers cat-a-corner on any size or shape of table. You can use it by itself or you can put a solid color tablecloth under it.

This is the perfect size to use by itself on a small table in an apartment or on a card table. (Maybe we need a 'card game pieces' transfer?)

Any transfer can go on these. It depends on what YOU want.
